THE MEDICAL CENTRE

Welcome to North Road Medical Center

1 The medical center is open from 8.30am until 6pm Monday to Friday. Appointments with the doctors and nurses are available both morning and afternoon.

2 You can make an appointment either in person or by telephone. If you need an appointment urgently, you will be seen on the same day. However, a same-day appointment may not necessarily be with your

unusual doctor. Patients may be seen by any member of the team.

3 If you would like to register with us, please speak to one of our receptions. If you decide to register with the medical center, you will need to complete a registration form. Patients register with the medical center rather than an individual doctor.

4 Each new patient is asked to complete a medical questionnaire. You should also make an appointment to see one of the nurses for a health check soon after registering. There is sometimes a delay in the transfer of

medical records from your previous doctor and this appointment gives us valuable information about your health.

5 The Out of Hours service is available from 6.30pm until 8 am Monday to Friday: at weekends from 6.30pm on Friday to 8am on Monday: and on Bank Holidays Telephone 0845 345 8995 to contact the Out of Service. They will arrange for a doctor to contact you. Alternatively you can contact NHS Direct (24 hours) on 0845 46 47 for medical advice or via the Internet at www.nhsdirect.nhs.uk

6 You can always get advice over the telephone. Late morning is the best time to contact the doctors and nurses at the medical Centre. Alternatively, you may telephone for.

7 If you are too ill to come to the medical Centre, you can arrange a home visit over the telephone. Most visits by doctors are made between 12 noon and 3p.m. If you are able to phone before 11 a.m, this helps us to plan the day.
